Agreement Between Arts Alliance, Parent and Student – September 2011 to June 2012

The Arts Alliance and Lesson Coordinators agree to:

1. Provide musical instruction in a supportive learning environment with qualified instructors.
2. Offer consistent, progressive lessons in a group lesson format or private lessons tailored for each individual student.
3. Facilitate choice of lesson time and location to our best ability.
4. Facilitate choice of group lesson size to the best of our ability.
5. Reserve consistent teaching areas and facilities for the school year of September to June.
6. Organize and present a student recital for all lesson students in April 2012.
7. Issue a lesson calendar with periodic updates throughout the year. This calendar will also be available on the Elementary Integrated Band web site calendar.
8. Provide a report twice during the year showing the student's progress.
9. Contact a parent/guardian in the event that any lesson is cancelled due to a teacher's absence.
10. Make up any lesson caused by teacher absence or school cancellation so that the full 27 lessons are fulfilled. Please note that teachers are not required to make up lessons due to student absence.
11. Offer financial aid for qualified students to the extent of available resources.

The Parent/Guardian in conjunction with the student agree to:

1. Pay the lesson fee in advance before the first lesson for all 27 lessons.
2. Attend lessons for the entire duration of the teaching term (27 lessons) to maintain the student's rate of musical progress.
3. Have the student prepared for lessons and encourage the student to come with a willingness to learn and positive attitude.
4. Call the Arts Alliance as early as possible at 978-562-1646 if the student is unable to attend their scheduled lesson.
5. Promptly have the student delivered to and picked up from lessons. Teachers are often on a tight schedule. It is important to keep lesson times on track. Please bring the student directly to the lesson.
6. Keep in contact with the teacher at reasonable regular intervals regarding student progress. Parents may make arrangements with lesson teacher to sit in on the lesson if desired.
7. Arrange a home playing schedule sufficient to attain satisfying results as directed by the lesson teacher.

Fees:

1. Lesson cost does not cover costs of lesson materials or instrument costs. Teachers may ask you to purchase additional materials depending on the level of proficiency attained by the student. This may include lesson books, instrument components (reeds, mouthpieces, etc.), or even instruments. This is more typical of students who have studied for several years or more.
2. **Lesson payment must be received by the Arts Alliance no later than Monday, September 23, 2011.**
3. The Arts Alliance and the lesson coordinators retain the right to cancel the registration of a student should tuition not be received by the deadline date. We may also contact a parent/guardian should a student disregard the standards and policies of his/her lesson teacher (practice, attendance, behavior, etc.)
4. No refunds are issued for lessons. As we contract with lesson teachers, these teachers depend on guaranteed lesson income over the course of the entire school year.
